

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-115, 21-137, 21-165, 21-178, 21-200, 21-218, 21-226, 21-249, 22-27, 22-63, 22-73, 22-82, 22-138, 22-145, 23-05, 23-42, 23-49, 23-67, 23-113 and 23-155, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-90,
3 21-115, 21-137, 21-165, 21-200, 21-218, 21-226 and 23-155, is
4 hereby further amended to read as follows:

5 "Section 4. Of the \$9,800,000 appropriated under this
6 act, \$2,800,000 shall be apportioned for public
7 projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei

11 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended
12 by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-115,
13 21-137, 21-165, 21-178, 21-200, 21-206, 21-218, 21-226, 21-249,
14 22-63, 22-138, 22-138, 22-145 and 23-67, is hereby further
15 amended to read as follows:

16 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
17 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
18 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
19 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
20 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
21 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
22 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
23 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
24 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
25 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated

1 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
2 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
3 appropriated under sections 3(a) to 3(as) of this act
4 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
5 designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsections 3(ad) and 4(2)(q) of this
7 act shall be the President of COM-FSM; the allottee of
8 funds appropriated under subsection 3(al) of this act
9 shall be the Secretary of the FSM Department of
10 Education or his designee. The allottee of funds
11 appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the
12 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
13 designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
14 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(c) of this act shall
15 be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the allottee of
16 funds appropriated under section 4(1) [~~and subsection~~
17 ~~4(3)(w)~~] of this act shall be the Vice President of the
18 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the
19 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
20 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this act shall be the
21 Secretary of the Department of Health and Social Affairs
22 or her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
23 under subsections 4(3)(d), 4(3)(y) and 4(3)(z) of this
24 act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
25 Education or his designee; the allottee of funds

1 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(ab), 4(4)(f) and
2 4(3)(p) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
3 Authority, the funds appropriated under subsection
4 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the President of the
5 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, the
6 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(x)
7 of this act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of
8 Madolenihmw Municipal Government or his designee; the
9 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(i), 4(3)(j)
10 and 4(3)(w) of this act shall be the Secretary of the
11 Department of Transportation, Communications and
12 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
13 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(ae) of this act shall
14 be the Secretary of the Department of Resources and
15 Development or his designee. The allottee of the funds
16 appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act
17 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee,
18 EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
19 subsection 5(6)(a) of this act shall be the Secretary of
20 the Department of Transportation, Communications and
21 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of the
22 funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act
23 shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority
24 (MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
25 subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno

1 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
2 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act
3 shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority;
4 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
5 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
6 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
7 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
8 30, 2026."

9 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
10 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
11 becoming law without such approval.
