A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1,2,6,8, and 9 of Public Law No. 23-121, as amended, by Public Law Nos.23-129, 23-144, and 24-01 to appropriate \$1,566,999 in supplemental funding from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025, to provide funding for the operations of the Executive Branch; Agencies, Boards, Authorities, and Commissions of the National Government; Grants, Subsidies, and Contributions; Capital and Human Resources Development; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
