A BILL FOR AN ACT

The 5 allottee of funds appropriated under sections 5(2) and 6 5(7) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State 7 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated 8 under subsection 5(1)(3) of this act shall be the 9 Mortlock Islands Development Authority (MIDA); the 10 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 11 5(1)(0), 5(1)(p) 5(1)(1) and 5(1)(4) of this act shall 12 be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his 13 designee; EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds 14 appropriated under subsection 5(1)(m) of this act shall 15 be the FSM Telecommunication Corporation; the allottee 16 of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(5) of this 17 act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development 18 Authority (SNDA); the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(6) of this act shall be the 19 20 Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the 21 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act 22 shall lapse on September 30, 2026." 23 24
