## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 22-157, as amended by Public Laws No. 22-179, 23-91 and 23-141, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under section 3(1) of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under section 3(2) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)a, 4(1)(b), 4(1)(c), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(i) [and], 4(3)(c), 4(3)(e) and 4(3)(k) of this act shall be the Secretary of the

Department of Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(c) and 4(3)(b) of this act shall be the Secretary of Health and Social Affairs or her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(e) of this act shall be the President of COM-FSM; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(f) of this act shall be the FSM NOC; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(d), 4(1)(e), 4(2)(h) of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Education or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(d),  $[\frac{4(3)(e)}{2}]$ , 4(3)(f) and 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(h) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC); the allottee of funds appropriated under sections 4(3)(j) and 4(3)(n) of this act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw; the allottee of funds appropriated under [sections 4(3)(k) and] section 4(3)(m) of this act shall be the Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(3)(1) of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Education or his designee;. allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 1 2 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk 3 State or his designee; the allottee of the funds 4 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be 5 the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) 6 7 of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal 8 Government or his designee; the allottee of the funds 9 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be 10 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the 11 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) 12 of this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. 13 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds 14 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30, 15 2026." 16 Section 3.
