A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-57, 20-61, 20-69, 20-90, 20-91, 20-96, 20-132, 21-92, 21-135, 21-168, 21-189, 21-247, 22-40, 22-84, 22-94, 22-114, 22-175, 22-202 and 23-104, by amending sections 3 and 5 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs in the state of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

11	amended, to read as follows:
12	"Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
13	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
14	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
15	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
16	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
17	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
18	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
19	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
20	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
21	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
22	under sections 2 and 3 of this act shall be the
23	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
24	designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
25	appropriated under subsections 2(a) to 2(af) and 2(ay)

1 of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government 2 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated 3 under subsections 2(aq) to 2(all) of this act shall be 4 the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the 5 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 6 3(1)(a), 3(1)(b), 3(1)(c), 3(1)(e), 3(1)(g), 3(1)(j), 7 3(1)(p), 3(1)(r), 3(2)(b), 3(2)(c), 3(2)(d), 3(2)(e), 3(2)(0), 3(3)(d), 3(3)(n), 3(3)(t) and 3(3)(x) of this 8 9 act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the 10 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(ai) of this act shall be the Secretary of Transportation, 11 12 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the 1.3 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 14 3(3)(f), 3(3)(1) and 3(3)(m) of this act shall be the 15 Lukenmoanlap of Kitti; the allottee of funds 16 appropriated under subsections 3(3)(q) and 3(3)(r) of 17 this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 18 19 4(1) and 4(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk 20 State or his designee; the allottee of the funds 21 appropriated under subsection 4(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the 22 23 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3) of 2.4 this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government 25 or his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated

under subsection 4(4) of this act shall be the Southern 1 2 Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 4(5) of this act 3 4 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority; the allottee 5 of the funds appropriated under subsection 4(7) of this 6 act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or 7 his designee. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 8 9 30, 2026." 10 Section 3.
