A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$130,536,291 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government; the operations of the National Public Auditor; the operations of Agencies, Boards, Authorities, and Commissions of the National Government; Special Programs; Grants, Subsidies, and Contributions; Capital and Human Resource Development; Compact Infrastructure Sector Grant Projects and Offices; and Compact IMF Grant Distributions; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
