A RESOLUTION

Expressing the sincere condolences and sadness of the Twenty-Fourth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to the family of the late Secretary Joses R. Gallen, former National Secretary of Justice, at his passing on September 11, 2025.

- 1 WHEREAS, the late Joses R. Gallen was born on January 19, 1956,
- 2 and devoted his legal career, which spanned over forty-five years,
- 3 to the service of all of the citizens of our Nation through the
- 4 advancement of the law at the state, national and international
- 5 levels; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the late Secretary Joses R. Gallen received his LL.B.
- 7 in Law from the University of Papua New Guinea and began his career
- 8 in the Pohnpei State Attorney General's Office as a Deputy District
- 9 Attorney (1980-1986), then he served as a Staff Attorney for the
- 10 Pohnpei State Legislature (1986-1987), followed by service at the
- 11 Department of Justice as a staff attorney (1987-1991); and
- 12 WHEREAS, the late Secretary Joses R. Gallen served as the
- 13 Deputy Chief of Mission for the FSM at the United Nations (1991-
- 14 1993), followed by heading the Division of International Law as the
- 15 Chief of Division for the FSM Attorney General's Office (1993-1995);
- 16 and
- 17 WHEREAS, the late Secretary Joses R. Gallen served as the
- 18 Acting Legislative Counsel for the FSM Congress (1995-1996), was a
- 19 Staff Attorney for the FSM Office of the Public Defender (1996-

- 1 1998), Chief of Litigation for the Chuuk State Attorney General's
- 2 Office (1998-2000), and was the Chief of Litigation at the Pohnpei
- 3 State Attorney General's Office (2000-2003), then was the Chuuk
- 4 State Attorney General (2003-2012), after which he was the General
- 5 Counsel for the Pohnpei Utilities Corporation (2013-2015); and
- 6 WHEREAS, the late Secretary Joses R. Gallen was confirmed as
- 7 the Secretary for the National Department of Justice in June of 2015
- 8 and he served in that position with distinction for eight years, and
- 9 will be remembered for his work ethic and legal expertise, as well
- 10 as, his willingness to mentor and train the next generation of
- 11 attorneys; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the late Secretary Joses R. Gallen's final position
- 13 was Attorney General for the State of Yap beginning in 2023, he was
- 14 also known over the many years for his community service and
- 15 dedication to the advancement of our citizens having served on the
- 16 FSM Olympic Committee, Pohnpei Economic Development Authority and
- 17 the Pohnpei State Scholarship Board; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the Twenty-Fourth Congress of the Federated States of
- 19 Micronesia recognizes the service and dedication that the late
- 20 Secretary Joses R. Gallen gave through his long legal career to our
- 21 Nation, it wishes to express its sincere condolences to his family,
- 22 former colleagues and friends at his passing; now, therefore,
- 23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Fourth Congress of the Federated
- 24 States of Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 2025, that Congress
- 25 hereby expresses its sincere condolences and sadness to the family
