## AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 19-150, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33, 20-48, 20-63, 20-71, 20-156, 20-175, 21-22, 21-52, 21-146, 21-156, 21-195, 21-213, 21-244, 22-25, 22-62, 22-111, 23-38, 23-55, 23-62, 23-131 and 23-150, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund priority infrastructure projects and other programs for Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

24	23-62 and 23-131, is hereby further amended to read as follows:					
25	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and					

1	lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
2	be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
3	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
4	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
5	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
6	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
7	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
8	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
9	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
10	under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of
11	the State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the
12	funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act
13	shall be the President of the Federated States of
14	Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee
15	of funds appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a) and
16	3(1(b) of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae
17	State or his designee, the allottee of funds
18	appropriated under subsections 4(1)(c), 4(1)(d),
19	4(1)(e), 4(1)(g), 4(1)(h), 4(1)(i), 4(1)(j), 4(1)(k),
20	4(1)(1), 4(1)(m), 4(1)(n), 4(1)(o), 4(2)(f), 4(3)(k),
21	4(3)(q), 4(3)(s), 4(3)(af), 4(4)(b), 4(4)(d) and
22	4(4)(f), shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority
23	(PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under

7	shall be the Luhk en Moanlap of Kitti, the allottee of
8	funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(ad) of this
9	act shall be the Chief Justice of Madolenihmw or his
10	designee, the allottee of funds appropriated under
11	subsection 4(3)(ae) of this act shall be the Chief
12	Justice of Kitti or his designee; the allottee of funds
13	appropriated under subsection 4(3)(an) of this act
14	shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and
15	Social Affairs or his designee; the allottee of funds
16	appropriated under subsection 4(3)(ar) of this act
17	shall be the Secretary of the FSM Department of
18	Education or his designee. The allottee of the funds
19	appropriated under subsections 4(3)(ak) and 4(3)(ao) of
20	this act shall be the Vice President of the Federated
21	States of Micronesia or his designee; the allottee of
22	funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(al) and
23	4(3)(ap) of this act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of
24	Madolenihmw Municipal Government or his designee. The
25	allottee of funds appropriated under sections 5(2) and

1	5(7) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State
2	or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
3	under subsection 5(1)(3) of this act shall be the
4	Mortlock Islands Development Authority (MIDA); the
5	allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
6	5(1)(0), $5(1)(p)$ $5(1)(1)$ and $5(1)(4)$ of this act shall
7	be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his
8	designee; EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds
9	appropriated under subsection 5(1)(m) of this act shall
10	be the FSM Telecommunication Corporation; the allottee
11	of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(5) of this
12	act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
13	Authority (SNDA); the allottee of funds appropriated
14	under subsection 5(1)(6) of this act shall be the
15	Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the
16	allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act
17	shall lapse on September 30, 2026."
