

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-187, 22-188, 23-03, 23-09, 23-11, 23-36, 23-59, 23-118, 23-124, 23-139, 23-145 and 24-16, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

14 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-180, as
15 amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-188, 23-11, 23-36, 23-118,
16 23-124, 23-139 and 24-16, is hereby further amended to read
17 as follows:

18 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
19 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
20 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for
21 in accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
22 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
23 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
24 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are
25 used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and

1 that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
2 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
3 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of
4 Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds
5 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall
6 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
7 or his designee; EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds
8 appropriated under section 3(1) of this act shall be
9 the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the
10 allottee of funds appropriated under section 3(2) of
11 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or
12 his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
13 appropriated under subsection 3(2)(x) of this act
14 shall be the Mayor of Utwe Municipal Government or his
15 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
16 subsection 3(2)(y) of this act shall be the Mayor of
17 Malem or his designee; the allottee of funds
18 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(b), 4(1)(k),
19 4(1)(l), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e),
20 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(p), 4(2)(s), 4(2)(t), 4(2)(u),
21 4(2)(v), 4(3)(q) and 4(2)(aa), 4(3)(a) 4(2)(ab) of
22 this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
23 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or
24 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
25 subsections 4(1)(a), 4(1)(j), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(j),

1 4(2)(k), 4(2)(l), 4(2)(m), 4(2)(r), 4(2)(x), 4(3)(m),
2 4(3)(n), 4(3)(s), 4(2)(n), 4(3)(s) and 4(3)(t) of this
3 act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority
4 (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
5 subsection 4(2)(i) of this act shall be the Secretary
6 of the Department of Education or her designee; the
7 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
8 4(2)(o) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Port
9 Authority (PPA); the allottee of funds appropriated
10 under subsections 4(2)(w), 4(2)(q) and 4(2)(z) of this
11 act shall be the Mayor of Sapwuahfik Municipal
12 Government or his designee, the allottee of funds
13 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(ac) and 4(2)(ad)
14 of this act shall be the Sokehs Municipal Government;
15 the allottee of funds appropriated under section
16 4(3)(e) of this act shall be the Secretary of the
17 Department of Health and Social Affairs; the allottee
18 of the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and
19 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State
20 or his designee; the allottee of the funds
21 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall
22 be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA);
23 the allottee of the funds appropriated under
24 subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno
25 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
