

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-31, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-41, 20-50, 20-77, 20-113, 21-24, 21-45, 21-83, 21-101, 21-133, 21-204, 21-220, 22-79, 22-113, 22-150, 23-65, 23-136, 23-165 and 24-08, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 20-31, as amended by

- 3 hereby further amended to read as follows:

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2 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-31, as amended by
3 Public Laws Nos. 20-41, 21-24, 21-83, 21-133, 21-204, 22-113,
4 23-65 and 24-08, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

5 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
6 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
7 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for
8 in accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
9 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
10 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
11 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are
12 used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and
13 that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
14 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
15 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of
16 Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds
17 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall
18 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
19 or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
20 appropriated under subsections 3(a) to 3(n) of this
21 act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
22 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
23 subsections 3(o) to 3(ae) of this act shall be the
24 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee
25 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(f),

1 4(1)(k), 4(1)(l), 4(1)(m), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c) and
2 4(3)(y) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
3 Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds
4 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a), 4(2)(d),
5 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i) and
6 4(2)(j) shall be the Secretary of the Department of
7 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or
8 his designee; 4(3)(g), 4(3)(v) and 4(3)(w) of this act
9 shall be the Secretary of Education or his designee;
10 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections,
11 4(3)(l) and 4(3)(t) of this act shall be the
12 Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti; the allottee of funds
13 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(o) of this act
14 shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation; the allottee
15 of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(j) of this
16 act shall be the Speaker of Madolenihmw Municipal
17 Government or his designee; the allottee of funds
18 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(p) of this act
19 shall be the Director of Land Grant Program; the
20 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
21 4(3)(r) of this act shall be the Secretary of Health
22 and Social Affairs or her designee; the allottee of
23 funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(u) of this
24 act shall be the Meninkeder of Madolenihmw. The
25 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection

1 4(3)(z) of this act shall be the Chief Justice of
2 Madolenhimw Municipal Government or his designee. The
3 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)
4 and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
5 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall
7 be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The
8 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(3)
9 of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal
10 Government or his designee. The allottee of funds
11 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall
12 be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
13 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5)
14 of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
15 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
16 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
17 September 30, 2026.”

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2 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
3 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
4 becoming law without such approval.
