

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting a grant from the United States Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in the amount of \$40,069,452 to provide funding support for the Kosrae International Airport Runway Rehabilitation project, including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1 WHEREAS, on September 18, 2025, the United States Federal
2 Aviation Administration (FAA) approved a federal funding
3 application submitted by the Government of the Federated States of
4 Micronesia and awarded a grant in the amount of \$40,069,452 to
5 fund the Kosrae International Airport Rehabilitation Project; and

6 WHEREAS, on September 19, 2025, the FAA, on behalf of the
7 United States Government, and the Department of Transportation,
8 Communications and Infrastructure and the Department of Justice,
9 on behalf of the FSM Government, executed the FAA AIP Grant
10 Agreement for the project; and

11 WHEREAS, the budget period for the grant, as stated in the
12 executed FAA AIP Grant Agreement, is four (4) years, or 1,460
13 calendar days, from the date of acceptance of the grant; and

14 WHEREAS, section 210(2) of title 55 of the Code of the
15 Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, requires
16 that for foreign financial assistance to be valid it must be
17 approved by Congress by resolution; now, therefore,

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Fourth Congress of the Federated
19 States of Micronesia, Second Special Session, 2025, that Congress

1 hereby approves and accepts the \$40,069,452 grant from the United
2 States Federal Aviation Administration, including all the terms
3 and condition, thereof; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
5 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated
6 States of Micronesia, the Secretary of the Department of
7 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure, the Secretary
8 of the Department of Justice, and the Secretary of the Department
9 of Finance and Administration.
