
A RESOLUTION

To ratify the Agreement to Establish the Pacific Resilience Facility.

1 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia joined other
2 Pacific Islands Forum members in signing the Agreement to
3 Establish the Pacific Resilience Facility (PRF) on September 10,
4 2025, in Honiara, Solomon Islands; and

5 WHEREAS, the PRF is a regional climate and disaster
6 resilience financing facility dedicated to helping the Pacific in
7 combating the climate crisis; and

8 WHEREAS, it is the first international financial
9 institution of this kind, hosted in the Pacific, and upon the
10 initiative of the Pacific Islands Forum, as an innovative way of
11 mobilizing climate resources, given the perceived slow pace in
12 global climate finance access; and

13 WHEREAS, the PRF will receive climate and disaster funding
14 grants for climate adaptations, disaster preparedness, nature-
15 based solutions, and loss and damage projects; and

16 WHEREAS, so far, several donor countries have pledged
17 funding commitments to the PRF and hopefully, other will be
18 encouraged to do so; and

19 WHEREAS, the Agreement to Establish the Pacific Resilience
20 Facility is considered a treaty that is subject to ratification by
21 the FSM Congress; now, therefore,

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Fourth Congress of the
2 Federated States of Micronesia, Second Special Session, 2025,
3 Congress hereby ratifies that the Agreement to Establish the
4 Pacific Resilience Facility; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
6 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
7 of Micronesia, the Secretary of the Department of Foreign Affairs,
8 and the Secretary of the Department of Justice, the Secretary of
9 the Department of Finance & Administration, the Secretary of the
10 Department of Resource and Development, and the Governors of each
11 state of the Nation.
