A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 19-150, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33, 20-48, 20-63, 20-71, 20-156, 20-175, 21-22, 21-52, 21-146, 21-156, 21-195, 21-213, 21-244, 22-25, 22-62, 22-111, 23-38, 23-55, 23-62, 23-131, 23-150, 24-23, 24-44 and 24-50, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund priority infrastructure projects and other programs for Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33, 20-48,
3 20-63, 20-71, 21-156, 21-195, 21-213, 21-244, 22-25, 22-62,
4 23-150, 24-23, 24-44 and 24-50, is hereby further amended to read
5 as follows:

6 "Section 4. Of the \$11,300,000 appropriated under this
7 act, \$3,000,000 shall be apportioned for priority
8 infrastructure projects and other programs in the state
9 of Pohnpei.

9 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
10 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
11 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
12 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
13 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
14 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
15 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
16 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
17 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
18 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
19 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of
20 the State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the
21 funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act
22 shall be the President of the Federated States of
23 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee
24 of funds appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a) and
25 3(1)(b) of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae

1 State or his designee the allottee of funds
2 appropriated under subsection 3(1)(c) of this act shall
3 be the Mayor of Malem Municipal Government or his
4 designee, the allottee of funds appropriated under
5 subsections 4(1)(c), 4(1)(d), 4(1)(e), 4(1)(g),
6 4(1)(h), 4(1)(i), 4(1)(j), 4(1)(k), 4(1)(l), 4(1)(m),

17 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
18 subsections 4(3)(f), 4(3)(i), ~~[4(3)(w)]~~, 4(3)(aw),
19 4(3)(ax), and 4(3)(aa) of this act shall be the Luhk en
20 Moanlap of Kitti, the allottee of funds appropriated
21 under subsection 4(3)(ad) of this act shall be the
22 Chief Justice of Madolenihmw or his designee, the
23 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
24 4(3)(ae) of this act shall be the Chief Justice of
25 Kitti or his designee; the allottee of funds

1 appropriated under subsection 4(3) (an) of this act
2 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and
3 Social Affairs or his designee; the allottee of the
4 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3) (ak) and
5 4(3) (ao) of this act shall be the Vice President of the
6 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the
7 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
8 4(3) (al), 4(3) (ap) , 4(3) (au) and 4(3) (av) of this act
9 shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw
10 Municipal Government or his designee. The allottee of
11 funds appropriated under sections 5(2) and 5(7) of this
12 act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
13 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
14 subsection 5(1)(3) of this act shall be the Mortlock
15 Islands Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of
16 funds appropriated under subsections 5(1)(o), 5(1)(p)
17 5(1)(1) and 5(1)(4) of this act shall be the Mayor of
18 Weno Municipal Government or his designee; EXCEPT THAT
19 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
20 5(1)(m) of this act shall be the FSM Telecommunication
21 Corporation; the allottee of funds appropriated under
22 subsection 5(1)(5) of this act shall be the Southern
23 Namoneas Development Authority (SNDA); the allottee of
24 funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(6) of this act
25 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The

authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2026."

4 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
5 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
6 becoming law without such approval.
