
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 203 of title 7 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended by Public Law No. 19-91, to allow a person serving in the United States Military who renounced citizenship by reason of military service to regain FSM citizenship, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2. Section 203 of title 7 of the Code
2 of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended
3 by Public Law No. 19-91, is hereby further amended to read as
4 follows:

5 "Section 203. Renunciation of FSM Citizenship.

6 (a) A FSM citizen, who knowingly and voluntarily
7 renounced his or her FSM citizenship, shall be a FSM
8 national. A person who made a renunciation of
9 citizenship by reason of, or as a requirement of, his or
10 her service in the United States Military shall be
11 deemed not to have voluntarily renounced citizenship and
12 may avail of dual citizenship permitted by
13 constitutional amendment, and as provided in paragraph c
14 of this section.

15 (b) A FSM national, who knowingly renounced his or
16 her FSM citizenship, not falling under subsection a, is
17 eligible to apply for naturalization subject to the
18 conditions under section 204(1) of title 7 of the Code

1 of the Federated States of Micronesia.

2 (c) A person serving in the United States Military
3 who, at any time, renounced FSM citizenship by reason
4 of, or as a requirement of, his or her service in the
5 United States Military, may apply with the FSM
6 Immigration and Passport Services to regain FSM
7 citizenship in accordance with the procedures and
8 formalities as provided by regulation. The regulation
9 under this subsection shall not impose a residency
10 requirement."

11 Section 2. This act shall become law with the approval of
12 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or by its
13 becoming law without such approval.
