

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-86, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-101, 22-102, 22-106, 22-140, 22-147, 22-168, 22-185, 22-197, 23-06 23-12, 23-39, 23-50, 23-64, 23-114, 23-135 and 24-04, by amending sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei, Kosrae and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

19 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
20 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
21 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
22 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
23 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
24 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
25 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used

1 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
2 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
3 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
4 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
5 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsection 3(1) of this act shall be
7 the Governor of the State of Kosrae or his designee;
8 EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
9 section 3(1)(q) of this act shall be the Mayor of Malem
10 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
11 funds appropriated under subsection 3(2) of this act
12 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
13 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
14 section 4 of this act shall be the President of the
15 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED
16 THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under
17 subsection 4(1)(c) of this act shall be the FSM
18 Telecommunication Corporation; the allottee of funds
19 appropriated under subsection 4(1)(g) of this act shall
20 be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC); the allottee

22 the Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw. The allottee of
23 funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(y) of this act
24 shall be the Luhkenmenlap of Kitti. The allottee of
25 funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(t) of this act

1 shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC). The
2 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
3 5(1), 5(2) and 5(7) of this act shall be the Governor of
4 Chuuk State or his designee; EXCEPT THAT the allottee of
5 funds appropriated under subsections 5(1)(a), 5(1)(b)
6 and 5(1)(o) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno
7 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
8 funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(i) of this act
9 shall be the Saramen Chuuk Academy School; the allottee
10 of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this
11 act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority
12 (MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
13 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno
14 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
15 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act
16 shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority;
17 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
18 5(6) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
19 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
20 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
21 30, 2026."
