

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 24-50

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 22-157, as amended by Public Laws No. 22-179, 23-91 and 23-141, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 22-157, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 22-197 and 23-141, is hereby further amended
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 4. Of the \$2,800,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$800,000 shall be apportioned for public projects
6 and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State.

22	Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-157, as amended by	
23	Public Laws Nos. 22-179 and 23-91, is hereby further amended to	
24	read as follows:	

1 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
2 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
3 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
4 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
5 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
6 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
7 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
8 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
9 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
10 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
11 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
12 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
13 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be
14 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
15 his designee; EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds
16 appropriated under section 3(1) of this act shall be the
17 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee
18 of funds appropriated under section 3(2) of this act
19 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
20 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
21 subsections 4(1)a, 4(1)(b), 4(1)(c), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b),
22 4(2)(d), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(i), 4(3)(c), 4(3)(e) and 4(3)(k)
23 of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
24 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his
25 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under

1 subsections 4(2)(c) and 4(3)(b) of this act shall be the
2 Secretary of Health and Social Affairs or her designee;
3 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
4 4(2)(e) of this act shall be the President of COM-FSM;
5 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
6 4(2)(f) of this act shall be the FSM NOC; the allottee
7 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(d),
8 4(1)(e), 4(2)(h) of this act shall be the Secretary of
9 the Department of Education or his designee; the
10 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
11 4(3)(a), 4(3)(d), 4(3)(f) and 4(3)(g) of this act shall
12 be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the
13 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(h)
14 of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation
15 (PUC); the allottee of funds appropriated under sections
16 4(3)(j) and 4(3)(n) of this act shall be the Meninkeder
17 Lapalap of Madolenihmw; the allottee of funds
18 appropriated under section 4(3)(m) of this act shall be
19 the Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia
20 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
21 under section 4(3)(l) of this act shall be the Secretary
22 of the Department of Education or his designee;. The
23 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
24 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
25 State or his designee; the allottee of the funds

1 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be
2 the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the
3 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3)
4 of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal
5 Government or his designee; the allottee of the funds
6 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be
7 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the
8 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5)
9 of this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.
10 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
11 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
12 2026."

13 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
14 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
15 becoming law without such approval.
