A RESOLUTION

To confirm the nomination of Mr. Henry H. Shrew to serve as the Consul General for the FSM Consul General Office in Honolulu, Hawaii.

1        WHEREAS, pursuant to section 207 of title 2 of the Code of  
2 the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, the  
3 President of the Federated States of Micronesia shall nominate  
4 and, with the advice and consent of the Congress, as provided  
5 in Section 2(d), Article X of the Constitution, shall appoint  
6 consul generals of the Federated States of Micronesia; and

7        WHEREAS the President of the Federated States of  
8 Micronesia has nominated Mr. Henry H. Shrew to serve as the  
9 Consul General for the FSM Consul General Office in Honolulu,  
10 Hawaii; and

11        WHEREAS, Mr. Shrew is presently the Acting Consul General  
12 at the FSM Consulate General Office in Honolulu, Hawaii; and

13        WHEREAS, Mr. Shrew has held several important positions,  
14 including Acting Consul General from 2010 to 2013, Deputy  
15 Assistant Secretary for European Affairs for the FSM Department  
16 of Foreign Affairs from 2007 to 2009 and with the Foreign  
17 Service Office at the FSM Consulate General Office in Portland  
18 from 2019 to 2020; and

1                   WHEREAS, Mr. Shrew possesses the essential qualifications  
2 that make him a suitable candidate to serve as the Consul  
3 General of the FSM Consulate General Office in Honolulu,  
4 Hawaii; now, therefore,

5           BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Fourth Congress of the  
6 Federated States of Micronesia, Second Special Session, 2025,  
7 that Congress hereby confirms the nomination of Mr. Henry H.  
8 Shrew to serve as the Consul General for FSM in Honolulu,  
9 Hawaii; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
11 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated  
12 States of Micronesia, the Governor of each state of the Nation,  
13 and Mr. Henry H. Shrew.
