

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$4,200,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei, and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$4,200,000, or so much thereof as may  
2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the  
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending  
4 September 30, 2026, for the purpose of funding public projects and  
5 social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei, and Chuuk  
6 states. The funds appropriated under this section shall be  
7 apportioned as follows:

8 Section 2. Of the \$4,200,000 appropriated under this act,  
9 \$600,000 shall be apportioned to fund public projects and social  
10 programs for the people of Yap.

2 Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.

3 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,  
4 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,  
5 including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of  
6 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
7 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for  
8 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are  
9 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the  
10 funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the  
11 Governor of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the funds  
12 appropriated under subsection 3(1) of this act shall be the Mayor  
13 of Malem Municipal Government or his designee. The allottee of  
14 the funds appropriated under subsection 3(2) of this act shall be  
15 the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee. The allottee  
16 of the funds appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the  
17 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;  
18 EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under section  
19 4(2) (a) under this act shall be the Mayor of Kapingamarangi  
20 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of funds  
21 appropriated under section 4(2) (b) under this act shall be the  
22 Mayor of Nukuoro Municipal Government or his designee; the  
23 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(2) (c) under this  
24 act shall be the Mayor of Sapwuaifik Municipal Government or his  
25 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under sections

1 4(2) (d), 4(2) (e) and 4(2) (o) under this act shall be the Mayor of  
2 Kolonia Town Government or his designee; the allottee of funds  
3 appropriated under sections 4(2) (f), 4(2) (g) and 4(2) (h) under  
4 this act shall be the Mayor of Sokehs Municipal Government or his  
5 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under sections  
6 4(2) (i), 4(2) (l), 4(2) (m), 4(2) (n), 4(2) (p), 4(2) (q), 4(3) (a),  
7 4(3) (b), 4(3) (c), 4(3) (e), 4(3) (f), 4(3) (g), 4(3) (i), 4(3) (l) and  
8 4(3) (m) under this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of  
9 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his designee;  
10 the allottee of funds appropriated under sections 4(2) (j) and  
11 4(2) (k) under this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation  
12 Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under section  
13 4(3) (h) of this act shall be the President of the COM-FSM  
14 Institute or her designee. The allottee of funds appropriated  
15 under section 4(3) (j) of this act shall be the Secretary of the  
16 Department of Health and Social Affairs or his designee; the  
17 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(3) (k) of this act  
18 shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC); the allottee of  
19 funds appropriated under section 4(3) (d) of this act shall be the  
20 Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw or his designee. The allottee  
21 of the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this  
22 act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the  
23 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this  
24 act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA);  
25 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of

1 this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his  
2 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
3 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development  
4 Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
5 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The  
6 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this  
7 act shall lapse on September 30, 2028.

8 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
9 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
10 becoming law without such approval.
