AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-121, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-130, 19-142, 19-145, 19-158, 20-09, 20-22, 20-51, 20-59, 20-70, 20-123, 20-162, 20-170, 21-35, 21-66, 21-112, 21-127, 21-176, 21-198, 22-07, 22-110, 22-182, 23-86, 23-159 and 24-53, by amending sections 3, 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of the states of Kosrae and Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 19-121, as amended  
2 by Public Laws Nos. 19-130, 19-142, 20-09, 20-70, 21-66, 21-  
3 176, 22-182, 23-86, 23-159 and 24-53, is hereby further  
4 amended to read as follows:

5 "Section 3. Of the sum of \$5,450,000 appropriated by

 16 23-86, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

17       "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and  
 18 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall  
 19 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
 20 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
 21 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
 22 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
 23 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
 24 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
 25 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum

1           appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
2           under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of  
3           Yap State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds  
4           appropriated under section 2(k) shall be the President  
5           of the Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of  
6           funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act  
7           shall be the President of the Federated States of  
8           Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee  
9           of funds appropriated under subsections 3(a) through  
10          3(z) shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his  
11          designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
12          subsections 3(aa) - 3(al1) shall be the Mayor of Lelu  
13          Town Government, or his designee EXCEPT THAT the  
14          allottee of fund appropriated under subsection 3(au) of  
15          this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae or his  
16          designee the allottee of funds appropriated under  
17          section 3(al2) of this act shall be the Mayor of Malem  
18          Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of

7 under subsection 4(2)(c) shall be the Office of  
8 Fisheries, Pohnpei State; the allottee of funds  
9 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(n) shall be the  
10 Secretary of the Department of Education or his  
11 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
12 subsection 4(3)(b) shall be the Pohnpei State Public  
13 Safety; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
14 subsections 4(3)(c) and 4(3)(e) of this act shall be the  
15 Meninkeder of Madolenihmw; allottee of funds  
16 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d) and 4(3)(m)  
17 shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The allottee of  
18 funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of  
19 this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his  
20 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
21 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock  
22 Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds  
23 appropriated under section 5(3) of this act shall be  
24 the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee.  
25 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection

1           5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas  
2           Development Authority. The allottee of funds  
3           appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be  
4           the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of  
5           the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act  
6           shall lapse on September 30, 2026."

7           Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
8           President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
9           becoming law without such approval.
