**The Honorable Victor ‘Vicky’ Gouland,** is a two-year member from the State of Chuuk representing Congressional Election District 2 or the Northern Namoneas Region in the Twenty-Fourth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia. He is the Chairman Committee on Transportation & Communications and serves as a member of the committees on Ways & Means; External Affairs; and the Resources and Development.

Senator Gouland joined the national body in 2013 as a member of the 18<sup>th</sup> Congress and has since been re-elected to maintain his seat.

Prior to joining the national legislative Body, Gouland was a member of the House of Representative in the Chuuk State Legislature ('01-'05). In 2013, Gouland was elected and seated as a member of the FSM Congress and as a new Congressman he held dual vice chairmanship of the Standing Committees on Transportation and Communications and also on Resources and Development, with membership on the Committee on External Affairs.

During the reorganization of the 19<sup>th</sup> Congress, Senator Gouland was appointed to

the chairmanship of the Standing Committee on Transportation and Communication, and has maintained the same role in the subsequent bodies from the 22<sup>nd</sup> thru the new 24<sup>th</sup> Congress. Gouland is known for his practical approach to matters leaving little to no room for fancy theories and scattered ideas.

Senator Gouland is married to Kiemena Gouland and they are blessed with several children and many grandchildren.
