The Honorable Jermy W. Mudong, is a two-year member from the State of Pohnpei representing Congressional Election District 2. He is the Vice Chairman of the Committee on Education and a member on the Congressional Standing Committees on: Health and Social Affairs, Judiciary and Governmental Operations, Resources and Development and finally the Committee on Transportation and Communications.

Senator Jermy W. Mudong is one of the new members of the Legislative Body and new to the political arena. Mudong brings to his new role a wealth of experience amassed in the field of Economics and Financial Management. His education quest from the start was thoroughly focused in the financial and economic landscape.

Mudong started his educational journey in 2006 with an Associate of Science from the College of Micronesia and continued at the University of Hawaii in Hilo where in 2010 he earned his Bachelor's in Economics. Maintaining his educational trajectory, Mudong successfully applied to be a candidate for the Master's Program at Hunan University in China. In 2014, Senator Mudong successfully reached his goal and awarded a Masters of Applied Economics from the Hunan University of International Economics and Trade in Hunan, China.

Upon his return to the FSM, Senator Mudong was immediately hired by the FSM Government's as an Economic Analyst for the Office of Statistics, Budget and Economic Management, from 2014 thru 2020. He took a 1-year hiatus from the National Government

to take on the role of Special Appointee Program (Macroeconomics)-A12 for the International Monetary Fund (IMF) from the end of 2020 thru November 2021. He was hired back by the FSM Government in 2022 as a Senior Economist for the Department of Finance and Administration and spent the next two years in the role until he accepted a 6-month post with the World Bank in January of 2024.

Upon completion of his posting with the World Bank, in July 2024 Mudong returned to the National Government to the Department of Finance and Administration and served as the Senior Economist and Acting Secretary for Budget and Economic Management. A responsibility he held for the Nation until he was elected and seated on May 11, 2025 as a Member of the 24th Congress of the FSM. Parallel to Mudong's professional experience is his extensive background in conferences, workshops and trainings in the vast landscape of financial management.

Senator Mudong is married to Memoreen Nennis and they are blessed with 4 children.
