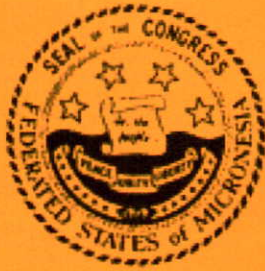

TO EXTEND THE PRESIDENTIAL EMERGENCY DECLARATION NO. 26-001,
DATED APRIL 13, 2026, AS AUTHORIZED BY ARTICLE X, SECTION 9(C) OF THE
CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA.

A RESOLUTION

To extend the Presidential Emergency Declaration No. 26-001, dated April 13, 2026, as authorized by Article X, Section 9(c) of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia.

1 WHEREAS, on April 13, 2026, the President of the Federated
2 States of Micronesia issued Emergency Declaration No. 26-001; and

3 WHEREAS, in accordance with Article X, Section 9 (c) of the
4 Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia, Congress has
5 the sole authority to revoke, amend, or extend a Declaration of
6 Emergency made by the President; and

7 WHEREAS, Congress has received documents and statements and
8 has held public hearings regarding the damage caused by Typhoon
9 Sinlaku, the tropical storm that led to the underlying disaster
10 resulting in Emergency Declaration No. 26-001; and

11 WHEREAS, Congress finds that Typhoon Sinlaku caused
12 significant damage in Chuuk to buildings, boats, roads, and
13 electrical infrastructure, and clean-up of the resulting disaster
14 is ongoing; and

15 WHEREAS, Congress supports efforts of the President and the
16 Executive Branch to secure all necessary funding, technical
17 assistance, and supplies to contain and clean-up the disaster in
18 Chuuk however, all funding from the date of this extension shall
19 be used for the relief efforts shall have the Department of

1 Environment, Climate Change and Emergency Management as allottee;
2 and

3 WHEREAS, Congress supports an extension of Emergency
4 Declaration No. 26-001 to further aid in recovery efforts; now,
5 therefore,

6 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Fourth Congress of the Federated
7 States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 2026, that Congress
8 hereby extends the President's Emergency Declaration No. 26-001,
9 as it applies to Chuuk until June 12, 2026, unless sooner revoked
10 by Congress; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
12 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
13 of Micronesia and the Governor of each state of the Nation.
