TO EXTEND PRESIDENTIAL EMERGENCY DECLARATION NO. 26-001, DATED
APRIL 13, 2026, AS AUTHORIZED BY ARTICLE X, SECTION 9(C) OF THE
CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA.

A RESOLUTION

To extend Presidential Emergency Declaration No. 26-001, dated April 13, 2026, as authorized by Article X, Section 9(c) of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia.

1 WHEREAS, on April 13, 2026, the President of the Federated
2 States of Micronesia issued Emergency Declaration No. 26-001; and

3 WHEREAS, in accordance with Article X, Section 9 (c) of the
4 Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia, Congress has
5 the sole authority to revoke, amend, or extend a Declaration of
6 Emergency made by the President; and

7 WHEREAS, on May 13, 2026, Congress extended the Declaration
8 of Emergency made by the President to June 12, 2026; and

9 WHEREAS, Congress has received documents and statements and
10 has held further public hearings regarding the damage caused by
11 Typhoon Sinlaku, the tropical storm that led to the underlying
12 disaster resulting in Emergency Declaration No. 26-001; and

13 WHEREAS, Congress finds that Typhoon Sinlaku caused
14 significant damage to buildings, boats, roads, and electrical
15 infrastructure, and clean-up of the resulting disaster is ongoing;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, Congress supports efforts of the President and the
18 Executive Branch to secure all necessary funding, technical
19 assistance, and supplies to contain and clean-up the disaster; and

1 WHEREAS, Congress supports an extension of Emergency
2 Declaration No. 26-001 to further aid in recovery efforts; now,
3 therefore,

4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Fourth Congress of the Federated
5 States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 2026, that Congress
6 hereby extends Presidential Emergency Declaration No. 26-001 until
7 September 16, 2026, unless sooner revoked by Congress; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
9 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
10 of Micronesia, and the Governors of each State of the Nation.
