Dear Mr. Speaker:

Your Committee on External Affairs, to which was jointly referred Presidential Communication No. 23-573 transmitting the National Government's proposed FY 2026 budget, begs leave to report as follows:

Presidential Communication No. 23-573 was transmitted to Congress with the *National Government Fiscal Year 2026 Recommended Budget* ("Budget Book"). Pursuant to rule 7, section 1(b), of the Official Rules of Procedure of the Twenty-Fourth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, your Committee has limited its review to portions of the budget under its jurisdiction. 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CONCLUSION


