It was explained to the Committee that this grant will supplement the ongoing program of planning and targeting specifically more remote areas in our Nation. The funding will support existing staff of the program. It will provide needed funding for supplies and equipment. The funding will work nicely with the additional money from the India Partnership and should better assist our underserved citizens.

The Committee inquired regarding the budget breakdown for this funding and was advised that funding will be given according to the formula already in place for the program.

The Committee is encouraged that more resources and healthcare professionals will be available for our underserved communities through this grant.

The Committee on Health and Social Affairs has reviewed C.R. No. 24-18 and considered all the testimony and documents received at the May 27, 2025, hearing. Your Committee on Health and Social Affairs is in accord with the intent and purpose of C.R. No. 24-18 and recommends its adoption by Congress.





Approving and accepting a grant in the amount of \$168,340, from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Office of the Secretary, to provide supplemental funding to support the project entitled: "Creating Equity by Improving Services Quality and Reach of Family Planning Services in the Federated States of Micronesia", including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1 WHEREAS, on March 28, 2025, the United States Department of
2 Health and Human Services, Office of the Secretary, issued a
3 Notice of Award No. 5 FPHPA006546 in the amount of \$168,340 to
4 provide supplemental funding to support the implementation of the
5 FSM Family Planning Program to create equity by improving the
6 service quality and reach of family planning services in the FSM;

8 WHEREAS, the budget period for this grant is from April 1,
9 2025, to March 31, 2026; and

10 WHEREAS, section 210(2) of title 55 of the Code of the
11 Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, provides
12 that for foreign financial assistance to be valid, it must be
13 approved by Congress through resolution; now, therefore,


14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Fourth Congress of the Federated
