AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 7-24, as amended, Pohnpei State public projects, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 7-63, 7-74, 7-84, 7-108, 7-132, 8-28 and 8-54, to modify the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 7-24, as amended by Public Laws  
2 Nos. 7-63, 7-74, 7-84, 7-108, 7-132, 8-28 and 8-54, is hereby further  
3 amended to read as follows:

4                   "Section 2. Madolenihmw and Kitti public projects. The sum of  
5                   \$875,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby  
6                   appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of  
7                   Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1992, for the  
8                   purpose of funding public projects in Madolenihmw and Kitti,  
9                   Pohnpei State. The sum appropriated by this section shall be  
10                  apportioned as follows:

11                   (1) Madolenihmw public projects

12                           (a) Section 1 water system development project --  
13                   funds may be expended for the purpose of matching funds  
14                   received from other sources.....\$50,000

15                           (b) Section 2 development projects to  
16                   be expended as follows:

11 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of  
12 the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such  
13 approval.
