

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145, 8-149 and 9-004, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116 and 8-145, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145, 8-149 and 9-004, for the purpose of changing an allottee of funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79,  
2 8-116 and 8-145, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

15 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-  
16 145, 8-149 and 9-004, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

17 "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,  
18 administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
19 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds  
20 appropriated under subsection (1)(a) of section 2 of this act shall be the PWP  
21 Development Authority, except that the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
22 subsection (1)(a)(iv)c) of section 2 shall be the Tolesom Economic Authority. The  
23 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(i), (1)(b)(ii), (1)(b)(iii)  
24 and (1)(b)(iv) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Fono. The allottee of the  
25 funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(v), (1)(b)(vi) and (1)(b)(vii) of section

1           2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Pis-Paneu. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
2           under subsections (1)(b)(viii), (1)(b)(x), (1)(b)(xi), and (1)(b)(xvii) of section 2 of  
3           this act shall be the Mayor of Weno. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
4           subsections (1)(b)(ix), (1)(b)(xii), (1)(b)(xiii), (1)(b)(xiv), (1)(b)(xv), (1)(b)(xvi), and  
5           (1)(b)(xviii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Weno Projects Coordinator. The  
6           allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(c) of section 2 of this act shall  
7           be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of the funds  
8           appropriated under subsection (1)(d) of section 2 of this act shall be the Lower  
9           Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
10          subsection (1)(e)(i) and (1)(e)(ii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Executive  
11          Director of the Hall Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
12          under subsection (1)(e)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Pattiw Development  
13          Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(iv),  
14          (1)(e)(v) and (1)(e)(vi) of section 2 of this act shall be the Weito Development  
15          Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(vii),  
16          (1)(e)(viii), (1)(e)(ix), (1)(e)(x), (1)(e)(xi)a, (1)(e)(xii), and (1)(e)(xiii) of section 2  
17          of this act shall be the Pattiw Development Authority. The allottee of the funds  
18          appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(xi)b of section 2 of this act shall be the  
19          Director of Public Safety for the State of Chuuk. The allottee of the funds  
20          appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(xi)c of section 2 of this act shall be the  
21          Director of the Chuuk State Department of Agriculture. The allottee of the funds  
22          appropriated under subsections (1)(f)(i), (1)(f)(ii) and (1)(f)(vi) of section 2 of this  
23          act shall be the Executive Director of COCA. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
24          under subsection (1)(f)(iii), (1)(f)(iv) and (1)(f)(v) of section 2 of this act shall be the  
25          Governor of the State of Chuuk. The allottee of the funds appropriated under

1 subsection (1)(f)(vii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Lower Mortlocks  
2 Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
3 (2)(a)(i) of section 2 of this act shall be the Luhkenkolwof of Sapwuafik. The allottee  
4 of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(ii) of section 2 of this act shall be  
5 the Chief Magistrate of Nukuoro. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
6 subsection (2)(a)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of  
7 Kapingamarangi. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(iv) of  
8 section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Kolonia Town. The allottee of the funds  
9 appropriated under subsections (2)(a)(v)a), (2)(a)(v)b) and 2(a)(v)i) of section 2 of  
10 this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Sokehs. The allottee of the funds  
11 appropriated under subsections (2)(b), (2)(c), (2)(e), (2)(f), (4)(b), (4)(c), (4)(d),  
12 (4)(e), (4)(f), (4)(g), (4)(h), (4)(i), (4)(j) and (4)(k) of section 2 of this act shall be  
13 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of the funds  
14 appropriated under subsections (2)(a)(v)c) of section 2 of this act shall be the  
15 Pohnpei Utility Corporation. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
16 (2)(d) of section 2 of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority. The  
17 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 3 of section 2 of this act shall be  
18 the Governor of the State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the funds  
19 appropriated under subsection (4)(a) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chairman of  
20 the Kosrae Sports Council. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections  
21 (4)(l) and (4)(n) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Lelu Municipal  
22 Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (4)(m) and  
23 (4)(o) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Malem Municipal Government.  
24 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(p) of section 2 of this act  
25 shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of the funds  
26 appropriated

1 under subsection (4)(q) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Tafunsak  
2 Municipal Government. The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
3 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes  
4 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
5 appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act  
6 shall not lapse."

7 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated  
8 States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
