

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-64, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-81, 19-97, 19-120, 19-137, 20-29, 20-86, 20-119, 21-31, 21-160, 22-18, 22-72, 22-122, 22-174, 22-200, 23-101, and 24-32, by amending sections 1 and 2 thereof, to change the use and extend the lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for Kosrae State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-64, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 19-81, 19-97, 19-120, 19-137, 20-29, 20-119, 22-18,
3 22-72, 22-200 and 23-137, is hereby further amended to read as
4 follows:

5 "Section 1. Purpose. The sum of \$3,050,000, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from
7 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
8 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for the
9 purpose of funding public projects and social programs
10 in the states of Kosrae and Pohnpei. The funds
11 appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as
12 follows:

5 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-64, as amended by
6 Public Laws Nos. 19-81, 19-97, 20-86, 20-119, 21-31, 21-160, 22-
7 18, 22-122, 23-101, and 24-32, is hereby further amended to read
8 as follows:

9 "Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
10 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
11 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
12 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
13 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
14 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
15 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
16 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
17 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
18 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
19 under section 1 of this act shall be the President of
20 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
21 PROVIDED THAT, the funds appropriated under subsections
22 1(d) shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
23 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
24 subsection 1(f) of this act shall be the Mayor of Malem
25 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of

1 funds appropriated under section 1(1)(i) of this act
2 shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee;
3 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
4 1(2)(1)(a)-(o), 1(2)(2)(a), 1(2)(2)(c), 1(2)(2)(o),
5 1(2)(4)(a)-(j) shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
6 Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated
7 under subsections 1(2)(2)(b), 1(2)(2)(d), 1(2)(2)(e),
8 1(2)(2)(f) and 1(2)(2)(n) shall be the Secretary of the
9 Department of Transportation, Communications and
10 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
11 appropriated under subsections 1(2)(2)(g), 1(2)(2)(h)
12 and 1(2)(2)(l) shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation;
13 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
14 1(2)(2)(m) shall be the Secretary of the Department of
15 Education or his designee; the allottee of fund
16 appropriated under subsections 1(2)(4)(k)-(s) shall be
17 the Governor of the State of Pohnpei. The authority of
18 the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act
19 shall lapse on September 30, 2028.”

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2 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
3 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
4 becoming law without such approval.
