
Dear Speaker Simina:

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by Public Law No. 20-135, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the states of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

7 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by
 8 Public Law No. 20-135, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

9 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 10 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 11 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 12 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 13 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 14 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 15 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 16 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
 17 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
 18 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
 19 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
 20 State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated
 21 under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President
 22 of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
 23 PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under
 24 subsections 3(a) to 3(q) of this act shall be the Mayor of
 25 Lelu Town Government or his designee; the allottee of

1 funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(j) of this act
2 shall be the President of the COM-FSM College or his
3 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
4 subsection 4(2)(p) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
5 Utility Corporation; the allottee of funds appropriated
6 under subsections 4(2)(a),(b),(c),(d),(e),(f),(g),(h),
7 (i),(k),(l),(m),(n),(o),(q),(r),(s), of this act shall be
8 the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
9 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee. The
10 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(b) of
11 this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
12 Health and Social Affairs or her designee. The allottee
13 of the funds appropriated under subsections 4(4)(j) of
14 this act shall be the Mayor of Pingelap Municipal
15 Government or his designee; the allottee of funds
16 appropriated under subsection 4(4)(k) of this act shall be
17 the Mayor of Mwokilloa Municipal Government or his
18 designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
19 subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act shall be the
20 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of
21 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act
22 shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority
23 (MIDA); the allottee of the funds appropriated under
24 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
25 Development Authority; the allottee of the funds

1 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be
2 the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the
3 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall
4 lapse on September 30, 2020."

5 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
6 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
7 becoming law without such approval.


