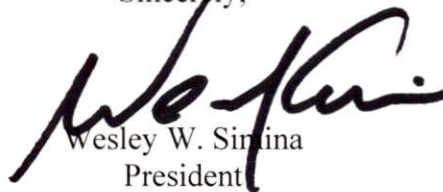
Dear Speaker Moses:

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-49, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-68, 16-76, 17-06, 17-10, 17-23, 17-30, 17-32, 17-45, 17-82, 17-85, 18-28, 18-45, 18-59, 18-86, 19-11, 19-106, 19-110, 20-108, 21-16, 21-122, 22-124, 23-77, and 24-26, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and extending the lapse date of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for each of the states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 16-49, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 16-68, 16-76, 17-06, 17-10, 17-82, 18-59 and
3 19-11, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
4 "Section 4. Of the sum of \$2,215,000 appropriated by
5 this act, \$610,000 is apportioned for Pohnpei State for
6 public projects and social programs.

1 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 16-49, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 17-10, 17-45, 17-85, 18-28, 18-86, 19-11,
3 19-106, 19-110, 20-108, 21-16, 21-122, 22-124, 23-77, and 24-26,
4 is further hereby amended to read as follows:

5 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
6 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
7 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
8 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
9 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
10 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
11 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
12 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
13 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
14 appropriated. The allottee of funds appropriated under
15 sections 2 and 4 of this act shall be the President of
16 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
17 PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under
18 subsection 2(1)(h) of this act shall be the Mayor of
19 Lelu Town Government or his designee; the allottee of
20 funds appropriated under section 4(1)(b) shall be the
21 Pohnpei Transportation Authority and the allottee of the
22 funds appropriated under section 4(1)(j) shall be the
23 Mayor of Kolonia Town Government; the allottee of funds
24 appropriated under sections 4(3)(l) and 4(3)(m)
25 subsection of this act shall be the Secretary of the

Department of Transportation Communications and
 Infrastructure or his designee. The allottee of funds
 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the
 Governor of Yap State. The allottee of funds
 appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(6) and 5(7) of
 this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock
 Islands Development Authority (MIDA). The allottee of
 funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act
 shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his
 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern
 Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of funds
 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be
 the Faichuk Development Authority. The funds
 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
 2028."

1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
