AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-54, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-62, 19-75, 19-79, 19-99, 19-119, 20-04, 20-56, 20-82, 20-127, 21-20, 21-117, 21-169, 21-174, 21-194, 21-205, 21-233, 22-15, 22-54, 22-109, 23-52, 23-85, and 24-43, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and extend the lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs in each of the states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 19-54, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 19-62, 19-79, 19-99, 19-119, 19-129, 19-173,
3 22-15, 22-54, 23-52 and 24-43, is hereby further amended to read
4 as follows:

5 "Section 4. Of the sum of \$4,800,000 appropriated by
6 this act, \$1,400,000 is apportioned for public projects
7 and social programs in the state of Pohnpei.

9 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-54, as amended
10 by Public Laws Nos. 19-62, 19-75, 19-99, 19-129, 20-04, 20-127,
11 21-20, 21-117, 22-15, 22-109, 23-85, and 24-43, is hereby
12 further amended to read as follows:

13 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
14 date. All fund appropriated by this act shall be
15 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
16 accordance with applicable laws including, but not
17 limited to, the applicable laws, including, but not
18 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
19 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
20 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
21 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
22 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
23 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
24 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
25 State. The allottee of funds appropriated under

1 sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of
2 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
3 PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under
4 subsections 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h),
5 (t), (u), (v), (ag), (ar) and (as) of this act shall be
6 the Mayor of Utwe Municipal Government or his designee;
7 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
8 3(k), (w), (x), (y), (z), (aa), (ab), (ac), (ad), (ae),
9 (af), (ah), (ai), (aj), (ak), (al), (am), (an), (ao),
10 (ap) and (aq) of this act shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak
11 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
12 funds appropriate under subsections 4(1)(a), (b), (c),
13 (e), (f), 4(2), 4(3)f) and 4(3)(aa) shall be the
14 Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
15 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the
16 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
17 4(1)(d), 4(3)(b), 4(3)(d), 4(3)(e), 4(3)(h), 4(3)(k),
18 4(3)(l) and 4(3)(y) shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
19 Authority (PTA). The allottee of fund appropriated under
20 subsection 4(3)(z) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
21 Utility Corporation. The allottee of funds appropriated
22 under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the
23 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee
24 of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act
25 shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority.

1 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(3)
 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal
 3 Government or his designee. The allottee of funds
 4 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be
 5 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
 6 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of
 7 this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.
 8 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
 9 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
 10 2028."

11 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
 12 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
 13 becoming law without such approval.
