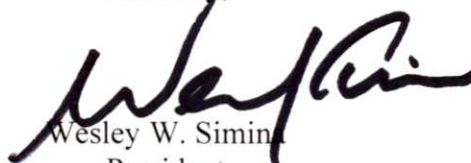
Dear Speaker Moses:

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 24-144, C.D.1

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 21-180, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-191, 21-234, 21-240, 22-21, 22-131, 22-146, 23-111, 23-134, and 24-05 by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and extend the lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei, and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 21-180, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 21-191, 21-240 and 24-05, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follow:

4 "Section 4. Of the \$1,680,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$480,000 shall be apportioned for public projects
6 and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State.

13 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-180, as amended by
 14 Public Laws Nos. 21-191, 21-234, 21-240, 22-21, 22-131, and
 15 23-111, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

16 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 17 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 18 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 19 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 20 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 21 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 22 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 23 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
 24 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
 25 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated

1 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
2 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
3 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be
4 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
5 his designee; PROVIDED THAT; the allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(b) and 4(1)(c) of
7 this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
8 Health and Social Affairs or his designee; the allottee
9 of funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(d) of this
10 act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Justice
11 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
12 under subsection 4(1)(e) of this act shall be the
13 Secretary of the Department of Resources and Development
14 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
15 under section 3(1) of this act shall be the Governor of
16 Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee of funds
17 appropriated under subsection 3(2) of this act shall be
18 the Mayor of Lelu Town or his designee; the allottee of
19 funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(a), 4(1)(f),
20 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f),
21 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(3)(c) 4(3)(g) and 4(3)(h), 4(3)(c),
22 4(3)(g) and 4(3)(h) of this act shall be the Secretary
23 of the Department of Transportation, Communications and
24 Infrastructure; the allottee of funds appropriated under
25 subsection 4(2)(i) of this act shall be the Chief

Magistrate of Sokehs Municipal Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(a) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(e) of this act shall be the Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(d) of this act shall be the Meninkeder of Madolenihmw. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA), the allottee of funds appropriated under section 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2028."

1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
