

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-10, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-51, 19-56, 19-72, 19-78, 19-96, 19-132, 19-163, 20-03, 20-25, 20-58, 20-76, 20-116, 21-29, 21-64, 21-196, 22-10, 22-133, 23-84, 23-163, 24-12, and 24-52, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the state of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

2           Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 19-10, as amended by  
3 Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-72, 19-78, and 24-52, is hereby  
4 further amended to read as follows:

5           "Section 4. Of the sum of \$2,800,000 appropriated by  
6 this act, \$800,000 is apportioned for public projects  
7 and social programs in the state of Pohnpei.

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2       Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-10, as amended by  
3 Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-72, 19-96, 20-25, 20-116, 21-29,  
4 21-64, 21-196, 22-10, 22-133, 23-84, 23-163, 24-12, 24-52, and  
5 24-83, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

6           "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
7 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
8 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
9 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
10 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
11 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
12 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
13 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
14 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
15 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
16 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
17 State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated  
18 under subsection 2(h) of this act shall be the President  
19 of COM-FSM. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
20 sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of  
21 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;  
22 PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under  
23 subsections 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h),  
24 (i), (j) and (k) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu  
25 Town Government; the allottee of funds appropriated

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1 under section 3(1) of this act shall be the Mayor of  
2 Malem Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee  
3 of funds appropriated under subsection 3(y) of this act  
4 shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal Government or  
5 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
6 3(ab) of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae or his  
7 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
8 subsections 4(1)(a), 4(1)(b), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h) ~~[and]~~,  
9 and 4(3)(f) 4(3)(o) of this act shall be the Secretary  
10 of the Department of Transportation, Communications and  
11 Infrastructure; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
12 subsections 4(2)(i), 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(d) of  
13 this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority;  
14 ~~[and the allottee of funds appropriated under~~  
15 ~~subsections 4(3)(f) and 4(3)(h) of this act shall be the~~  
16 ~~Pohnpei Utility Corporation]~~. The allottee of funds  
17 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(h) of this act shall  
18 be the Speaker of the Madolenihmw Municipal Government  
19 or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated  
20 under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act shall  
21 be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The  
22 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of  
23 this act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development  
24 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
25 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern

1           Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of funds  
2           appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be  
3           the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the  
4           allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act  
5           shall lapse on September 30, 2028."

6           Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
7 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming  
8 law without such approval.
