

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-141, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-145, 20-163, 20-164, 20-190, 21-05, 21-33, 21-48, 21-67, 21-91, 21-182, 21-193, 22-34, 22-69, 22-77, 22-160, 22-177, 23-04, 23-20, 23-27, 23-103, 24-07 and 24-93 by amending sections 3 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs in the state of Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 20-141, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 20-145, 20-163, 20-164, 21-33, 21-48, 21-67,
3 22-69, 22-77, 22-160, 22-177, 23-04, 23-103, 23-168 and 24-07,
4 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

5 "Section 3. Of the \$12,800,000 appropriated under this
6 act, \$2,000,000 shall be apportioned for priority
7 infrastructure projects and other projects and programs
8 in the state of Kosrae.

15 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-141, as amended
16 by Public Laws Nos. 20-163, 20-164, 20-190, 21-05, 21-33, 21-48,
17 21-91, 21-193, 22-34, 23-20, 23-27, 23-103, 24-07 and 24-93, is
18 hereby further amended to read as follows:

19 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
20 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
21 managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with
22 applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial
23 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for
24 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
25 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act,

1 and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
2 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
3 section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State or his
4 designee PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
5 subsections 2(a) and 2(b) of this act shall be the President of
6 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the allottee
7 of funds appropriated under subsection 2(k) of this act shall be
8 the Yap State Public Service Corporation (YSPSC). The allottee
9 of the funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act
10 shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
11 his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated
12 under subsections 3(a), 3(b), 3(c), 3(e), 3(f), 3(g), 3(h), 3(j),
13 3(k), 3(l), 3(m), 3(n), 3(o), 3(p), 3(q), 3(s), 3(t), 3(u), 3(v),
14 3(w), 3(x), 3(y), 3(z), 3(a3) to 3(a10), 3(a30) and 3(a31) of
15 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
16 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
17 3(d), 3(i), 3(r), 3(a2) and 3(a11) to 3(a25) of this act shall be
18 the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal Government or his designee;
19 EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
20 3(1)(a16) and 3(1)(a23) of this act shall be the Mayor of Malem
21 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee the allottee
22 of funds appropriated under subsections (a27), (a28) and (a29) of
23 this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee;
24 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(a26) is the
25 Secretary of the FSM Department of Education or his designee; the

1 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1) of this act
2 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
3 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee
4 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a) to 4(2)(s),
5 4(2)(ab), 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b), 4(3)(c), 4(3)(d), 4(3)(k), 4(3)(x),
6 4(3)(a6), 4(4)(a), 4(4)(b), 4(4)(c), 4(4)(d), 4(4)(g), 4(4)(h),
7 4(4)(i), 4(4)(j) and 4(4)(k) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
8 Transportation Authority (PTA) except that the allottee of funds
9 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(l) of this act shall be the
10 Administrator of MiCare program or her designee; the allottee of
11 funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(n) of this act shall be
12 the Secretary of the Department of Health and Social Affairs or
13 her designee, the allottee of funds appropriated under
14 subsections 4(2)(h), 4(2)(q), 4(2)(u), 4(2)(ac), 4(2)(v),
15 4(2)(w), 4(2)(x), 4(2)(z) and 4(3)(r) of this act shall be the
16 Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications and
17 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
18 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(y) of this act shall be the
19 Pohnpei Port Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under
20 subsection 4(2)(aa) of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of
21 Sokehs Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of fund
22 appropriated under subsection and 4(4)(l) of this act shall be
23 the Mayor of Pingelap Municipal Government; the allottee of funds
24 appropriated under subsection and 4(4)(m) of this act shall be
25 the Chief Magistrate of Mwoakilloa Municipal Government; the

1 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3) (e),
2 4(3) (f), 4(3) (j), 4(3) (p), 4(3) (w) and 4(3) (z) of this act shall
3 be the Menin Keder Lapalap of Madolenihmw; the allottee of funds
4 appropriated 4(3) (a5) shall be the Secretary of the Department of
5 Health and Social Affairs. The allottee of the funds
6 appropriated section 5 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
7 State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
8 appropriated under subsections 5(g) and 5(j) of this act shall be
9 the FSM Telecommunication Corporation or its designee and the
10 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 5(d) and 5(e) of
11 this act shall be the FSM Secretary of the Department of
12 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his
13 designee. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
14 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2028.”

15 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
16 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
17 becoming law without such approval.
