

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-141, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-145, 20-163, 20-164, 20-190, 21-05, 21-33, 21-48, 21-67, 21-91, 21-182, 21-193, 22-34, 22-69, 22-77, 22-160, 22-177, 23-04, 23-20, 23-27, 23-103, 24-07 and 24-93 by amending sections 3 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs in the state of Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

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Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 20-141, as amended

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by Public Laws Nos. 20-145, 20-163, 20-164, 21-33, 21-48, 21-67,

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22-69, 22-77, 22-160, 22-177, 23-04, 23-103, 23-168 and 24-07,

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is hereby further amended to read as follows:

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“Section 3. Of the \$12,800,000 appropriated under this

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act, \$2,000,000 shall be apportioned for priority

14 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-141, as amended
 15 by Public Laws Nos. 20-163, 20-164, 20-190, 21-05, 21-33, 21-48,
 16 21-91, 21-193, 22-34, 23-20, 23-27, 23-103, 24-07 and 24-93, is
 17 hereby further amended to read as follows:

18 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 19 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
 20 managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with
 21 applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial
 22 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for
 23 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
 24 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act,
 25 and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum

1 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
2 section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State or his
3 designee PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
4 subsections 2(a) and 2(b) of this act shall be the President of
5 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the allottee
6 of funds appropriated under subsection 2(k) of this act shall be
7 the Yap State Public Service Corporation (YSPSC). The allottee
8 of the funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act
9 shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
10 his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated
11 under subsections 3(a), 3(b), 3(c), 3(e), 3(f), 3(g), 3(h), 3(j),
12 3(k), 3(l), 3(m), 3(n), 3(o), 3(p), 3(q), 3(s), 3(t), 3(u), 3(v),
13 3(w), 3(x), 3(y), 3(z), 3(a3) to 3(a10), 3(a30) and 3(a31) of
14 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
15 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
16 3(d), 3(i), 3(r), 3(a2) and 3(a11) to 3(a25) of this act shall be
17 the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal Government or his designee;
18 EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
19 3(1)(a16) and 3(1)(a23) of this act shall be the Mayor of Malem
20 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee the allottee
21 of funds appropriated under subsections (a27), (a28) and (a29) of
22 this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee;
23 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(a26) is the
24 Secretary of the FSM Department of Education or his designee; the
25 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1) of this act

1 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
2 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee
3 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a) to 4(2)(s),
4 4(2)(ab), 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b), 4(3)(c), 4(3)(d), 4(3)(k), 4(3)(x),
5 4(3)(a6), 4(4)(a), 4(4)(b), 4(4)(c), 4(4)(d), 4(4)(g), 4(4)(h),
6 4(4)(i), 4(4)(j) and 4(4)(k) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
7 Transportation Authority (PTA) except that the allottee of funds
8 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(l) of this act shall be the
9 Administrator of MiCare program or her designee; the allottee of
10 funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(n) of this act shall be
11 the Secretary of the Department of Health and Social Affairs or
12 her designee, the allottee of funds appropriated under
13 subsections 4(2)(h), 4(2)(q), 4(2)(u), 4(2)(ac), 4(2)(v),
14 4(2)(w), 4(2)(x), 4(2)(z) and 4(3)(r) of this act shall be the
15 Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications and
16 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
17 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(y) of this act shall be the
18 Pohnpei Port Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under
19 subsection 4(2)(aa) of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of
20 Sokehs Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of fund
21 appropriated under subsection and 4(4)(l) of this act shall be
22 the Mayor of Pingelap Municipal Government; the allottee of funds
23 appropriated under subsection and 4(4)(m) of this act shall be
24 the Chief Magistrate of Mwoakilloa Municipal Government; the
25 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(e),

1 4(3)(f), 4(3)(j), 4(3)(p), 4(3)(w) and 4(3)(z) of this act shall
2 be the Menin Keder Lapalap of Madolenihmw; the allottee of funds
3 appropriated 4(3)(a5) shall be the Secretary of the Department of
4 Health and Social Affairs. The allottee of the funds
5 appropriated section 5 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
6 State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
7 appropriated under subsections 5(g) and 5(j) of this act shall be
8 the FSM Telecommunication Corporation or its designee and the
9 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 5(d) and 5(e) of
10 this act shall be the FSM Secretary of the Department of
11 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his
12 designee. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
13 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2028.”

14 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
15 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
16 becoming law without such approval.
