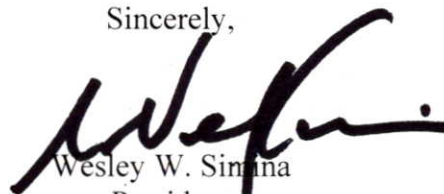
Dear Speaker Moses:

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-57, 20-61, 20-69, 20-90, 20-91, 20-96, 20-132, 21-92, 21-135, 21-168, 21-189, 21-247, 22-40, 22-84, 22-94, 22-114, 22-175, 22-202, 23-104, 24-51, and 24-57, by amending sections 3 and 5 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs in the state of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 20-57, 20-61, 20-91, 21-189, 24-45 and 24-57, is
3 hereby further amended, to read as follows:

4 "Section 3. Of the \$9,000,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$3,000,000 shall be apportioned for priority
6 infrastructure projects and other projects and programs
7 in the state of Pohnpei.

11	Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by	
12	Public Laws Nos. 20-57, 20-61, 20-91, 21-92, 21-135, 21-168,	
13	21-189, 21-247, 22-114, 22-175, 23-104, 24-45, 24-51, 24-57 and	
14	24-68, is hereby further amended, to read as follows:	
15	"Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse	
16	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be	
17	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in	
18	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not	
19	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The	
20	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these	
21	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used	
22	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that	
23	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum	
24	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated	
25	under sections 2 and 3 of this act shall be the	

1 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
2 designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
3 appropriated under subsections 2(a) to 2(af) and 2(ay)
4 of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government
5 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
6 under subsections 2(ag) to 2(al2) of this act shall be
7 the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the
8 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
9 3(1)(a), 3(1)(b), 3(1)(c), 3(1)(e), 3(1)(g), 3(1)(j),
10 3(1)(p), 3(1)(r), 3(2)(b), 3(2)(c), 3(2)(d), 3(2)(e),
11 3(2)(o), 3(3)(d), 3(3)(n), 3(3)(t) and 3(3)(x) of this
12 act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the
13 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
14 3(3)(c), 3(3)(y) and 3(3)(ai) of this act shall be the
15 Secretary of Transportation, Communications and
16 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
17 appropriated under subsections 3(3)(f), 3(3)(l) and
18 3(3)(m) of this act shall be the Lukenmoanlap of Kittu;
19 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
20 3(3)(q) and 3(3)(r) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
21 Utility Corporation; the allottee of funds appropriated
22 under subsection 3(3)(aj) of this act shall be the
23 Secretary of the Department of Resources and Development
24 or her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
25 under subsection 3(3)(ak) of this act shall be the

1 Governor of Pohnpei state or his designee; the allottee
2 of the funds appropriated under subsections 4(1) and
3 4(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or
4 his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated
5 under subsection 4(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks
6 Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of
7 funds appropriated under subsection 4(3) of this act
8 shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his
9 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
10 subsection 4(4) of this act shall be the Southern
11 Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the
12 funds appropriated under subsection 4(5) of this act
13 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority; the allottee
14 of the funds appropriated under subsection 4(7) of this
15 act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or
16 his designee. The authority of the allottee to obligate
17 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
18 30, 2028."
