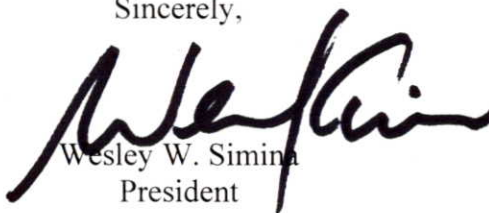
Dear Speaker Moses:

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-10, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-51, 19-56, 19-72, 19-78, 19-96, 19-132, 19-163, 20-03, 20-25, 20-58, 20-76, 20-116, 21-29, 21-64, 21-196, 22-10, 22-133, 23-84, 23-163, 24-12, and 24-52, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the state of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

2 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 19-10, as amended by
3 Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-72, 19-78, and 24-52, is hereby
4 further amended to read as follows:

5 "Section 4. Of the sum of \$2,800,000 appropriated by
6 this act, \$800,000 is apportioned for public projects
7 and social programs in the state of Pohnpei.

21 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-10, as amended by
22 Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-72, 19-96, 20-25, 20-116, 21-29,
23 21-64, 21-196, 22-10, 22-133, 23-84, 23-163, 24-12, 24-52, and
24 24-83, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

25 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse

1 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
2 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
3 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
4 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
5 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
6 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
7 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
8 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
9 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
10 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
11 State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated
12 under subsection 2(h) of this act shall be the President
13 of COM-FSM. The allottee of funds appropriated under
14 sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of
15 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
16 PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under
17 subsections 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h),
18 (i), (j) and (k) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu
19 Town Government; the allottee of funds appropriated
20 under section 3(l) of this act shall be the Mayor of
21 Malem Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee
22 of funds appropriated under subsection 3(y) of this act
23 shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal Government or
24 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
25 3(ab) of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae or his

1 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
2 subsections 4(1)(a), 4(1)(b), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), and
3 4(3)(f) 4(3)(o) of this act shall be the Secretary of
4 the Department of Transportation, Communications and
5 Infrastructure; the allottee of funds appropriated under
6 subsections 4(2)(i), 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(d) of
7 this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority.
8 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
9 4(3)(h) of this act shall be the Speaker of the
10 Madolenihmw Municipal Government or his designee. The
11 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 5(1),
12 5(3) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
13 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
14 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be
15 the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The
16 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of
17 this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
18 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
19 subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk
20 Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to
21 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
22 September 30, 2028."

1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
3 law without such approval.

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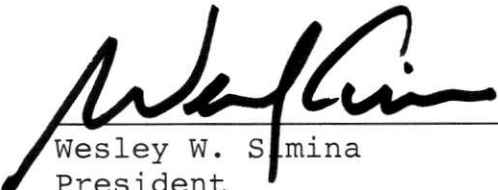
